




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



1. LED Sensor Light Wire:


- a. CAREFUL NOT TO DAMAGE WIRE when installing mixer.
- b. WIRE NOT TO TOUCH METAL.
 - i. \underline{HOOK} inside opening of the C washer to hold wire in place.



2. Mount Sensor Control Unit:

a. 4 screws supplied.

2 x FITERS # 2 between mixer outlet hose and sensor control unit




3. Install Inlet & Outlet Connections To Sensor Control Unit:

a. Connect A to B, C to D and secure with 2 x QUICK FIT HOSE CLIPS # 1.

i. NOTE: 2 x FITERS # 2 between mixer outlet hose and sensor control unit (refer drawing above).

4. Install 4 x AA Batteries (not supplied):


- a. Tighten lock screw.
- b. Position battery box anywhere in cabinet.
 - i. The extension wire is included.
 - ii. NOTE: Only use extension if required (shorter is best).
 - iii. MUST BE SUPPORTED NOT HANGING FROM WIRES.



LED light

5. Sensor Connections:

- a. YELLOW (Blue LED light).
- b. BLACK (Touch sensor).
 - a. Ensure the S/steel hook sits in groove,
- c. RED (Battery) and WAIT 10 SECONDS.
 - i. LED light will stay on for approx. 5 seconds then will go off automatically.
 - ii. WAIT 1 MINUTE before use. SYSTEM IS SET.
- d. RESET: Disconnect battery wire and WAIT 10 SECONDS.



CHECK:

- 1. Turn on water supply, check for leaks.
- 2. Check mixer operation and flow.
 - a. To Reset Sensor Disconnect battery wire wait 1 min (refer to No.6 .
 - b. Low Flow CLEAN FILTERS (Refer No.3 in instructions).
- 4. 4 X AA batteries are fitted in battery box (Not supplied).
- 5. Wires not touching any metal.
- 6. All senor connections.

MIXER OPERATION:

- 1. Turn handle to the ON position.
- 2.. To Activate & Shut Off: Touch any part of mixer **EXCEPT THE PULL-DOWN HAND PIECE**.
- 3. Each time when used on or off there will be **1 flash** on the sensor pad.
- 4. DO NOT leave handle in the ON position for long periods or overnight, turn


handle to the OFF position.

5. Manual Override (2 Options)

a. Remove Control Sensor Unit (Refer No 3 in instructions).
Connect A to D by removing quick clips, connect and re-fit quick clip.

OR

b. Turn mixer on with touch, with the water running disconnect the RED battery wire. NOTE: Sensor must be operating.



MAINTENANCE & CARE:

1. Clean only with a soft damp cloth and dry with a soft cloth.

a. DO NOT use any cleaners use a mild detergent mixed with water.

2. If the sensor LED light is flashing, this indicates the batteries will need replacing,

replace with 4 x 4AA batteries.
